

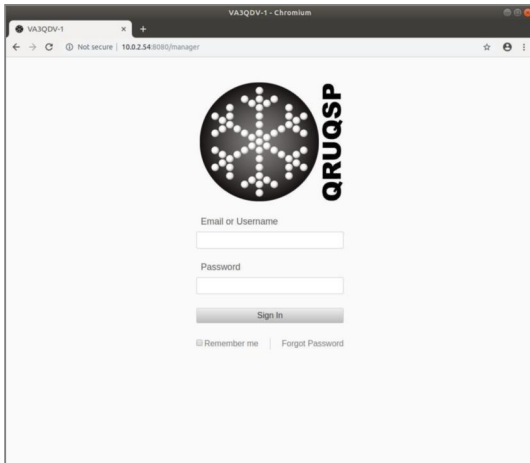
Clearing Contacts before Field Day

You'll want to create at least a few contacts before the actual Field Day event to make sure you've got the hang of it. After experimenting, you'll want to clear contacts before starting on field day.

Try clicking all of the buttons and entering data into all of the fields. You can review the other tutorials about Field Day Logger to become more familiar with the features that are available.

Once you are done experimenting, follow the steps in this tutorial to clear the contacts and reset your system for Field Day.

Step 1 of 5 - Login to QRUQSP.org Subscription



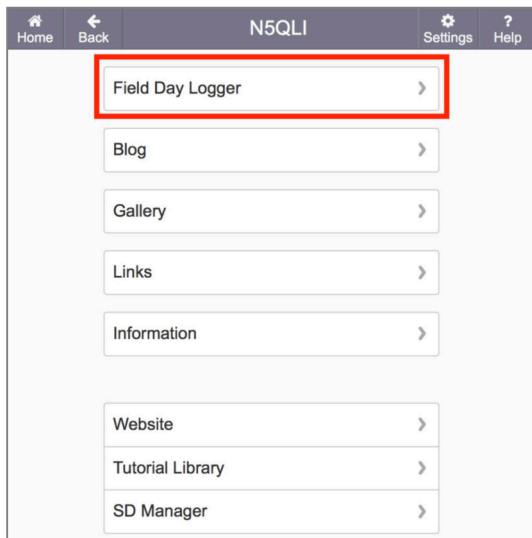
Open a web browser and connect to your QRUQSP.org subscription.

Enter your login information and click the Sign In button.

****NOTE:** You can click the remember me checkbox so you don't have to enter the information each time.


Step 2 of 5 - Select Field Day Logger



Select Field Day Logger from the main menu

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
Step 3 of 5 - Select Settings


Step 4 of 5 - Clear Contacts before the Field Day event begins
