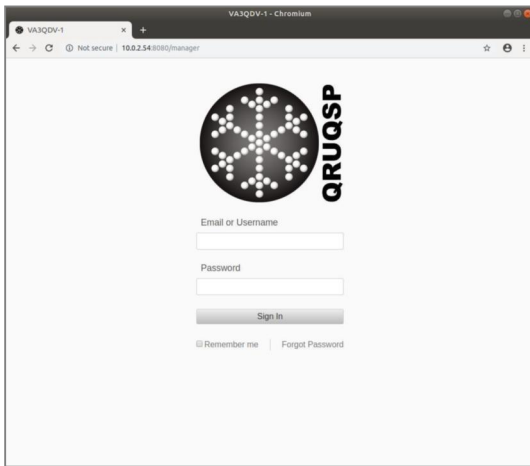


# Add Contacts to Field Day Logger

This tutorial shows how to log contacts in the Field Day Logger

## Step 1 of 4 - Login to QRUQSP.org Subscription



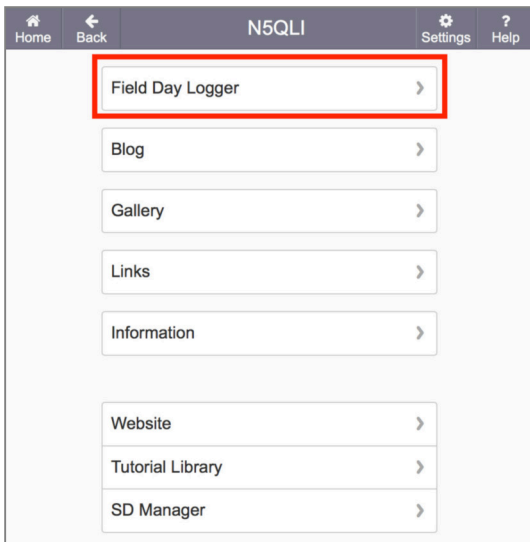
Open a web browser and connect to your QRUQSP.org subscription.

Enter your login information and click the Sign In button.

**\*\*NOTE:** You can click the remember me checkbox so you don't have to enter the information each time.


## Step 2 of 4 - Select Field Day Logger


Add Contact

Add contacts to your log by entering the exchange information in the **Call sign**, **Class**, **Section**, **Frequency**, **Band** and **Mode** fields.

Press enter or click on "Add Contact" to save this exchange into your contacts log.

NOTE: Shown here are the optional **Operator** and **Notes** fields which can be enabled under settings.

Add Contact

As you enter call signs the system will search to see if they already exist in your log. It will show you what contacts you've made on what modes with that call sign.

Duplicate contacts will be highlighted in red.

- On a wide screen duplicates will be shown to the right as shown in this image.
- On a narrow screen, such as a mobile phone, duplicates will be shown below the area where you are logging contacts.

NOTE: According to the Field Day rules, contacts are allowed using **Phone**, **CW** and **Digital** modes and stations can be worked once per band per mode.
