We will need to arrange a meeting with you in Barrie prior to the course start date to hand out the books and USB memory sticks. Preferred method of payment for the course is by e-transferring the money to treasurer@barriearc.com (indicate that it is for the ham course in the comments).

All classes will start at 7 pm on Google Meet video conferencing <u>https://meet.google.com/</u>. You will receive the meeting code before the course starts. Each class will be approximately 2 hours long (ends approximately 9 or 9:15pm).

The final exam consists of 100 multiple choice questions with a minimum pass mark of 70%. Obtaining a mark of 80% or higher will also earn you access to the HF (shortwave) ham bands. The final exam will be administered using video monitoring by the examiners via Google Meet.

In class we will be using the student notes found on the USB memory stick, with the Canadian Amateur Radio Basic Qualification Study Guide (9th Edition) from COAX Publications being used as a reference. Further information on the course and about ham radio is also found on the memory stick.

Total cost for the course is \$100 (\$60 if you already have the Basic Study Guide) which must be paid before the first class. Those who pass the course and obtain their call sign will receive a full membership to the Barrie Amateur Radio Club for the remainder of that membership year.

If necessary, the book and the USB stick can be mailed to you via Canada Post at your expense.
