# Barrie Amateur Radio Club Members Only Operating Classic 2021 Contest Rules

#### 1. General

- 1.1. The purpose of this event is to encourage individual on-air operating skills and club member radio activity.
- 1.2. Participants must be a member of the Barrie Amateur Radio Club in good standing.
- 1.3. The contest is open to all licence classes.
- 1.4. Participants must adhere to all ISED rules and regulations for their licence/certificate class.
- 1.5. Participation is on an individual basis only; no group entries.
- 1.6. Contest begins February 01, 2021 at 00:00 UTC and ends February 28, 2021 at 23:59 UTC.
- 1.7. Participants must follow all current COVID 19 restrictions/health guidelines however they might apply to their contest activities.

### 2. OSO's and Scoring

- 2.1. QSO's can count once only per band regardless of mode.
- 2.2. QSO modes eligible for this contest are Phone (SSB, AM, FM) and CW.
- 2.3. One (1) point will be awarded for each QSO.
- 2.4. QSO's must be made direct i.e., simplex (station to station).
- 2.5. Cross band and/or cross mode contacts do not qualify for QSO.
- 2.6. Contact through repeaters, nodes, hotspots or internet do not qualify for QSO.
- 2.7. No Contact on Calling Frequencies (3.885 AM, 7.290 AM, 14.286 AM, 50.125 SSB, 52.525 FM, 144.2 SSB, 146.52 FM, 222.1 SSB, 432.1 FM, 446.0 FM). You may initiate a call on a Calling Frequency but must move to another frequency to complete the QSO and exchange.
- 2.8. Contact QSO's submitted to other contests will not be eligible for this contest.

## 3. Multiplier/Bonus Points

- 3.1. For this contest there will be no multipliers applied to the QSO points.
- 3.2. Bonus points will be awarded on reaching QSO thresholds.
- 3.3. An additional 10 points may be added to the QSO point score for each complete 25 QSO's. For example, 105 QSO points will be scored an additional 40 points. 105 divided by 25 = 4.x. There is no limit to the number of additional bonus points that can be obtained.

#### 4. Exchange

4.1. For the purpose of this contest QSO's must include the following exchange: Signal Report RS(T) and the First Name of the contact operator.

#### 5. Awards and Category of Entry

- 5.1. Contest awards will be awarded in the following categories:
  - 5.1.1. High Score Phone only
  - 5.1.2. High Score CW only
  - 5.1.3. High Score Mixed (Phone and CW)
  - 5.1.4. High Score Rookie Category (Any Amateur licenced on or after 2018)
  - 5.1.5. High Score Overall (Highest Score of the contest)

#### 6. Logs

- 6.1. A detailed contest log must be submitted and contain the following information:
  - 6.1.1. Name of participant and callsign
  - 6.1.2. Category that the log is to be scored under
  - 6.1.3. Call sign of the station worked
  - 6.1.4. Name of Operator and Signal Report
  - 6.1.5. Date of QSO
  - 6.1.6. Time of QSO in UTC or EST
  - 6.1.7. Mode Phone or CW
  - 6.1.8. Frequency
- 6.2. If a participant wishes to be considered for more than one category, separate logs representing the requirements of that category must be submitted.
- 6.3. As well as the log of QSO's a summary sheet is required for each entry. The summary sheet shall indicate the total number of QSO's made, the total bonus points and the total score.
- 6.4. Logs must be received no later than March 7, 2021.
- 6.5. Logs and summary sheet are to be submitted to:
